ENROLMENT PROCESS

RETURNING STUDENT

- 1. Receive **MDC Academy Programs Prospectus**, thoroughly read through timetable, terms and conditions and special conditions before enrolling.
- 2. Fill out an **online enrolment form** to secure a place in one or more academies. This must be done prior to term commencement.
- 3. Pay a placement **deposit fee of \$50 to secure a place** for student in one or more academies. This fee will make up part of a student's first term fees. **The deposit is paid prior to commencement of each term throughout the year.*
- 4. Once the enrolment form has been received you will be sent a **welcome email to confirm your enrolment** as well as your current term invoice, payable prior to taking your first official lesson at MDC.

NEW STUDENT

- 1. **Register for a free trial class** with one or all of the academies via melbournedancecentre.com
 - * A trial registration needs to be filled out per child or student
 - * Only a parent or guardian may fill out a registration form. Any form filled out by a minor will register the form invalid
- 2. **Receive an email from MDC** confirming your child's/student's trial date and times.
- 3. Attend the trial lesson/s.
- 4. After the trial is complete you will be sent out an **online enrolment form** via email. This will need to be completed prior to your next lesson. The online form can be complete at home via the email sent out to you or at the Melbourne Dance Centre reception.
- 5. Pay a placement **deposit fee of \$50 to secure a place** for your child in your chosen academy. This fee will make up part of your child's first term fees. **The deposit is paid prior to commencement of each term throughout the year.*
- 6. Once the enrolment form has been received you will be sent a **welcome email to confirm your enrolment** as well as your current term invoice, payable prior to taking your first offical lesson at MDC.

> If you wish to for-go the trial class and join one of the MDC affiliate academies immediately to lock in you/your child's position on the day of your choice then you can skip steps 1-3 and immediately complete steps 4-6.

MDC ENROLMENT DEPOSIT

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MELBOURNE BALLET ACADEMY

Levels and examination participation is determined at the discretion of the Melbourne Ballet Academy's Principal. To be eligible to sit an examination, students must participate in 2 weekly RAD classes if they are available.

ADVANCED PART TIME STUDENTS

Students who are over 18 years of age and are of an advanced level are able to participate in the MONDAY advanced classes. Selection into these programs are at the discretion of the directors.

DAU SQUADS/ COMPETITION TEAMS

Only students who participate in a jazz class are eligible to participate in the jazz competition squad classes. Students learn 1 or more routines to compete under the DanceArts United's comp squad throughout the year. A high attendance rate must be sustained in order to maintain position within the squad team.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- MDC Academy classes are available on term basis only.
- Fees must be paid prior to or on the date student commences classes. (Paying via direct deposit is advisable as reception can get hectic)
- Academy class groups are based on student's *age as at 1 Jan* or determined by level of skill in relation to the standard present within each age range in any given year. Placement is at the discretion of the Directors
- An enrolment form must be correctly filled out and received by administration in order to participate in classes
- Students must be in full uniform at all times, this includes correct footwear and hair style
- As a part time student, absences must be kept to a minimum to avoid class disruption. Administration must be notified of any absences in advance
- All changes made to a student's enrolled classes must be sent in writing via email to info@melbournedancecentre.com
- · Any special medical consideration must be included in detail in the enrolment form
- MDC Associate Performance Academy, DanceArts United, Melbourne Ballet Academy, Melbourne Vocal Academy and Theatre Arts are all performing arts academies, therefore all enrolled students are expected to perform in both Open Day and respective end of year performances.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Theatre Arts presents a complete theatre program for young artists who wish to further explore their passion for performance. Run by industry professionals, the Theatre Arts program will tailor to each successful applicants needs, and will mentor and develop all the relevant techniques and attitudes needed to be successful in today's industry.

With the focus squarely on performance techniques students will present three productions throughout the year's program; a play, a vocal showcase or cabaret and culminating with the presentation of a musical theatre showcase, all to be held in Melbourne Dance Centre's own theatre space, the MDC Theatre.

The program will take place one day a week and consists of group vocal, and drama classes, with each performing arts discipline working closely together and complimenting the overall vision of the program. Theatre Arts, led by musical theatre professionals Daniel Ryan and Callum Warrender and its patron Melbourne Dance Centre, is excited to bring a new edge to performance training for the youth of Melbourne.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Theatre Arts is looking for a tight group of focussed and determined young performers to partake in the program. We are looking for students who are passionate and willing to push past their inhibitions to become open and expressive performers. They must be diligent with their training and practice methods and display good organisation skills and discipline.

To be eligible for the program, students must be 11 years or above as of January 1 2021. Prior experience is not necessary to receive placement in the program.

HOW IT WORKS

The program will commence in February and continue through to December once their final performance has been presented.

Holidays and break periods are scheduled around program based events though are likely to align with the Victorian School Terms. Students will be notified of these breaks at the commencement of each school term

**Please note that extra rehearsal hours may be required outside of the prescribed timetable and only in preparation for performances.

EXPECTATIONS UPON ENROLMENT

As the program is designed to be goal oriented toward set skill achievement as well as the presentation of performances, full attendance and punctual arrival to class is imperative unless there are extenuating circumstances.

Students will receive songs and scripts that are expected to be memorised and practised outside of their scheduled training hours.

Participants agree to conduct themselves in a professional manner and adhere to traditional classroom etiquette or as directed.

TERM, REVIEW AND HOLIDAY

- 1. The program runs from February through to December.
- 2. Holidays and break periods are scheduled in-line with the Victorian school terms and is clarified on the timetable. Some performances may sit throughout the holiday breaks. Students and parents will receive notification of these performances as soon as they become available.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Tuition fees are due before or on the first day of starting each term. With approval, payment plans can be arranged. A payment must be made at the beginning of the program. Failure to make payment can result in termination of the students enrolment in the program.
- 2. Students are expected to act with grace and respect to all fellow students, staff, teachers and any other member/attendant of Melbourne Dance Centre.
- 3. Students are expected to take their training seriously and to show constant progress throughout the program.
- 4. Participants agree to conduct themselves in a professional manner and adhere to traditional classroom etiquette or as directed.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE ASSOCIATE PROGRAM

To be eligible for the program, students must be within the age specifications listed in the table above. The program is available to beginner, intermediate and advanced level students. A students level and capabilities is determined by, and at the discretion of, the Directors through either an audition process or, if the applicant is already a member of DAU or Melbourne Ballet Academy, through class observance.

All students are accepted into the Associate Training Program unless extenuating circumstances renders DAU unable to cater for a student's particular needs, or if the student's current or past injuries or illnesses prevent the student from participating as per reasonable safe dance practice. A medical certificate may be requested before an offer of position is granted to evaluate whether the student will be able to participate in the vigorous training regime of the scholarship program.

All decision made are final and are at the Director's sole discretion.

ASSOCIATE PROGRAM SPECIFICATIONS

- · DanceArts United is an affiliate of the Melbourne Dance Centre hub alongside fellow training institutes Melbourne Ballet Academy (specialists in RAD Syllabus training) and Acrobatics Melbourne (specialist acrobatic and tumbling training).
- The RAD classes are a compulsory part of the Associate Training Programs and are taken in conjunction with Melbourne Ballet Academy under the direction of Nica Lee ARAD. Associate students are also eligible to be selected by MBA Director. Nica Lee ARAD, to participate in RAD examinations.
- · Acrobatics lessons are run in conjunction with Acrobatics Melbourne. Acrobatics lessons are not a compulsory component of the Associate Training Program. Levels are determined by the Acrobatics Melbourne instructors.
- All Associate students are members of the DAU Competition Squad and Performance Team and are required to represent DAU in State and potentially National level competitions.
- Students from all Associate Programs will be selected for in-house and external performances to represent DAU. Selection is at the discretion of the directors.
- Private coaching sessions are available to all students, and students are highly encouraged to take up the opportunity for the purpose of extra one on one technique training and the opportunity to perform and gather solo performance experience. Students will be able to represent DAU in State and National Competitions. Private coaching sessions are run in conjunction with Melbourne Dance Centre.

EXPECTATIONS UPON ENROLMENT

TERM, REVIEW AND HOLIDAY

EXPECTATIONS FOR COACHING PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS

TERM, REVIEW AND HOLIDAY

- Program commences on the first lesson and is on going per week until the batch is ended. Another batch can be added and commenced at any time.
- Holidays and break periods are scheduled in-line with the Victorian school terms. Coaching is not available during break periods unless under special circumstances.

SCHEDULES AND ATTENDANCE

- Participants are expected to be early and on time for their sessions. Coaches are unable to go overtime or to re-schedule. All requests for changes to coaching times must be submitted as a written request via administration and not directly to the coaches during or outside of lesson times.
- Participants are expected to treat coaches with respect by working hard, knowing work from previous sessions and immediately applying corrections in order to make progress.
- A minimum of 24 hour notice is required for cancellations. Notices must be made via email to info@melbournedancecentre.com. If there are unforeseen circumstances that prohibits a student from attending a lesson, participants must notify administration via phone. Continued tardiness or absenteeism may result in termination of their coaching program.
- The length of time taken to choreograph a finished piece is dependent on the students dedication and practise outside of their coaching session. We advise students to record their last routine run each session.
- Participants are expected to act with grace and respect to all fellow participants, staff, coaches/ mentors and the remaining members of MDC.

EXPECTATIONS FOR DAU/MBA SQUAD MEMBERS

- Students who are a member of the DAU Squad or a MBA soloist must perform in at least 2 competitions throughout the year.
- Students must maintain at least 1 half hour session per week in order to be eligible to compete as a DAU Squad member or a MBA soloist.
- Students can only compete in the styles of dance that they attend in group classes at DAU and MBA.

FEES

- Coaching Program fee is dependent on each individual coach's fees. Coaches are only available on specific days.
- Payments must be made prior to commencement of the first coaching session or by the due date specified on invoice. Classes can not commence without a payment being made prior to the first lesson.
- Fees may not be refunded or transferred under any circumstances, please book wisely.
- Cash payments must be made direct to Melbourne Dance Centre administration staff (NOT the respective teachers/coaches during operating hours.

COACHES

- Our coaches are industry professionals and may not be available at all times. A replacement coach will be provided at the directors discretion.
- The coaches and mentors listed will change on occasion due to the nature of using industry professionals. MDC will inform program members of these changes as soon as information becomes available.
- Coaches cannot be substituted by students partway through a program/batch of lessons unless written permission has been granted by the MDC directors.
- Coaches are not permitted to give out their personal contact details. Please respect the coach's privacy and channel all communication through MDC administration.

What happens now?

- Students/parents choose two of the above eisteddfods and book via the particular competition's website for a spot in the competition. Coaches will verify the category that a student will be competing in. Ask administration for assistance if you are having any difficulties.
- Students are encouraged to compete in as many eisteddfods as possible without interference with training or school commitments.
- Students who are being considered for international eisteddfods will be notified via email.
- Students representing DAU in competitions must always present themselves in a professional manner and wear their DAU Squad jacket. Squad jackets are available to purchase through Nancy at reception.
- Please note: Student's participation in eisteddfods is used as an enhancement to student training and confidence building. Receiving an award in competitions is not the goal, but a bonus, as an adjudicator's opinion of who should place is subjective. We believe competition training and performances should be used to encourage young dancers and promote an increased focus on technical improvement, confidence building and performance experience. Adjudicator's comments are also a great manner in which to receive a third party's critiques to use as a further teaching aid.
- It is highly advised that students should purchase a DVD of their performance on stage so that they may study and observe how they performed as well as to show their coaches so that they can go over corrections in the classroom.



CODE OF CONDUCT

DANCE STUDENTS

- Students must show respect for teachers and staff at all times during class, lunch time, performances etc. Students may be asked to leave the class or studio if it is deemed appropriate and if the student is disrupting other students from learning.
- Dancers are expected to focus and pay attention to the Teacher's instructions and keep talking to a minimum.
- Students should review material and practice at home on a consistent basis.
- Students should always be kind and courteous to their fellow students.
- Dancers are encouraged to establish new friendships with other dancers in their classes. We encourage teamwork and fairness.
- Dancers are expected to treat fellow class mates with respect.
- Bullying will not be tolerated.
- Students who knowingly cause damage to any properties at MDC will be required to pay for damages.
- Long hair should be tied back and no jewellery or watches allowed. Extra, non-uniform items can cause injury to the student as well as their fellow classmates.
- Students must arrive minimum 15 minutes prior to commencement of class. Students who are late put themselves at risk of injuries as they will not have warmed up efficiently. Teachers reserve the right to refuse access to students who are late. Students who are late or absent must notify administration via text or email prior to the date.
- Dancers are expected to attend classes regularly. Dancers who miss classes are encouraged to meet with a fellow dancer to discuss and go through any missed material. If a student has prior knowledge of a future absence it is important to communicate this with your instructor(s) and administration.
- Students must be in correct uniform and colours of the school. Doing so promotes community and less
 risk of injury especially in disciplines such as acrobatics. Teachers and staff reserve the right to refuse
 access to students who are not in correct attire.
- Water bottles are the only drinks permitted in the studios. Students will be asked to remove any other drinks and to clean up spills.
- Food is not permitted in the studios at all times. Students will be asked to clean up any mess made.
- Chewing gum is strictly prohibited at MDC.
- Students must have any medications required available with them at all times.
- Students are expected to keep their dressing rooms, lockers, toilets and eating areas clean at all times. Students will be asked to clean up any mess left behind.
- MDC is not responsible for any lost personal items. Please only bring what is required for class.
- Students should label all shoes and property belonging to them. Labelled items can be returned to students by our administration if found.
- Mobile phones should only be used in classes to record routines for practise and only used when given permission by their teacher. Recordings posted on social media should reflect on the company in a positive way. Any footage that is poorly representing the school should not be posted and students will be asked to delete it. Please keep to private groups as much as possible when sharing.
- On social media, students should always reflect the values of the school. Only positive comments should be made about your school and other students. Failure to do so could see the child removed from the school.
- Students should let teachers know when they are ill or injured either at the beginning of class or when/if it occurs during the lesson.
- Students must ask teachers to leave the dance room for whatever reason.
- Students are to remain on the premises during lunch unless written permission has been given to staff that they are able to leave. Students should wait inside for parents to pick them up. Staff is not required to look after a student once their lesson is complete.

MDC Code Of Conduct

CODE OF CONDUCT

PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- All students should be encouraged to dance but not forced.
- Teachers will talk to students about their progress and give constructive criticism. We encourage parents to do the same.
- Parents should aim to get their child to the studio 15 min prior to the commencement of class. For the younger students, please ensure that the child has been taken to the toilet and has been fed.
- Students must be in correct uniform and colours of the school at all times. Doing so promotes community and less risk of injury especially in disciplines such as acrobatics. Teachers and staff reserve the right to refuse access to students who are not in correct attire.
- Parents/guardians will not have access to the interior of the dance studios. MDC is fitted with windows into each studio for viewing. Teachers may allow a parent of a child who is nervous to enter the studio to stay with the child on their first day. This is at the discretion of the teacher and only for students under the age of 9.
- Parents/guardians must speak and treat teachers, and MDC staff with respect. Any abusive behaviour
 verbally or physically will not be tolerated. Parents and student will be removed immediately from the
 studio and be asked not to return.
- Parents/guardians should take up any complaints or questions in regards to a teachers conduct with administration immediately. We advise you to email your complaint to <u>admin@danceartsunited.com</u> if any concerning issue occurs. We take your concerns very seriously.
- Parents/guardians must understand that a decision made by a teacher &/or directors is final.
- We discourage comparison toward or against other dancers each dancer is an individual with different goals and objectives and they must be praised on their own personal achievements.
- Try not to set unrealistic expectations for your child.
- Please remain encouraging to the students at all times both for your child and for the other students at MDC. We believe in promoting good sportsmanship and community whether it be prior, during or after classes, watching a video, or as an audience member during performances.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide your child to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Keep the teacher and the MDC administration informed if your child is ill or unable to attend classes.
- Endeavour to establish good communications with the school, teachers and staff.
- Make sure to keep abreast of up to date information and events and everything else that is going on for your chosen academy/s and ensure that you are receiving, reading and responding to all emails & texts.
- Do not raise issues or disagreements publicly. Please send all concerns to <u>admin@danceartsunited.com</u> where it will be forwarded on to the Directors who will endeavour to look into your concern at their earliest convenience.
- Always collect your child promptly at the end of a class.
- All fees must be paid on time otherwise your child may risk losing their place in the class.
- Always support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Dancers are expected to stay up to date on studio happenings/performances and competitions. Notices are always available on the members page on our website and via email.
- Parents/ Guardians should promote practising at home and should let staff know if a child is needing more assistance.

MDC Code Of Conduct

CODE OF CONDUCT DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

Dancers that breach the code of conduct will first of all be reminded of the rules.

- Repeatedly breaching the code of conduct may result in the student being made to sit out of class if appropriate.
- Continuous breach of the code of conduct will result in the parents being informed at the end of the class by the Dance Teacher to discuss the situation. If there is no improvement in behaviour, then parents will be contacted by the Dance Teacher and they will be invited to discuss the future behaviour of their child and agree joint strategies for monitoring.
- In extreme cases where physical violence, verbal abuse or intentional damage to property is involved, the sequence of actions outlined above will be by-passed and the Dance Teacher will contact the parents as a first step. Exclusion of the child from the school may be considered.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read the below information carefully.

1. FEES

- a. Prices quoted are on a term basis unless otherwise stated. There are 4 terms per year and terms are based on the Victorian School dates. All tuition fees are payable in advance, on or before the 1st day of each term or within 7 days from invoice date, (whichever is the later).
- b. All sundry fees (including enrolment, rehearsal for competitions or concerts, exam & videos) are payable in advance and on their respective due dates. Extra rehearsal fees will be charged for the end of year concert.
- c. Cash payments must be made direct to Melbourne Dance Centre administration staff (NOT the respective teacher/s during operating hours.
- d. Late Payments: Where fee payments are not received by the due date, an administration fee of \$10.00 per month will be incurred, unless prior arrangements have been made in writing with the Administrator fourteen (14) days before the due date. Failure to pay fees by the due date may affect the student's continuation of classes and Melbourne Dance Centre shall have the right to refuse access to classes and performances and withhold reports. If payment is subsequently made, credits for missed classes will not be issued.
- e. In the event that Melbourne Dance Centre incurs any expense in relation to the collection of any fees and charges, it will be entitled to charge (you) for these expenses, which shall include but not be limited to debt collection agency fees, legal costs and disbursements.
- f. You acknowledge and agree that Melbourne Dance Centre subject to any relevant privacy legislation, may disclose personal information to obtain credit reports either to assess credit rating or to collect fees and for this purpose obtain personal information from an entity that provides commercial credit worthiness information and disclose personal information to credit reporting or collecting agencies before, during or after entry of this agreement.
- g. Melbourne Dance Centre and it's affiliated companies (DanceArts United, Melbourne Ballet Academy, Acrobatics Melbourne, Theatre Arts & Melbourne Vocal Academy) reserves the right to cancel a class if there are less than 10 students enrolled per term.

2. DEPOSIT

- a. A \$50 deposit is to be paid prior to the commencement of each term.
- b. The \$50 deposit locks in you/your child's enrolment in a Melbourne Dance Centre program and enables MDC to ensure class numbers for each class is maintained at a manageable level while also representing the opportunity cost of declining another student's application in favour of you/your child's enrolment.
- c. The \$50 deposit will be counted as a part payment and put toward the paying off of the full term fees.
- d. A deposit will be payable prior to the commencement of each term throughout the year as nominated in this enrolment form.
- e. Attendance into class/es can be restricted if the deposit hasn't been paid prior to the commencement of the new term's classes.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read the below information carefully.

3. WITHDRAWALS

- a. Students are enrolled on a per annum (yearly) basis however if a student wishes to withdraw, notice is required in writing. The withdrawal fee applied is calculated as the tuition fees payable for the full term less any tuition charges accrued (for the term). The Withdrawal Fee shall not exceed 10 weeks and represents the opportunity cost of declining another student's application in favour of the withdrawing student at the time of enrolment. To avoid confusion, parents / students are asked to offer notice of withdrawal in writing as a student's mere discontinuation of classes will not be deemed a 'Withdrawal'.
- b. If a student withdraws due to medical reasons rendering the student totally incapacitated for 30 days or more, a pro-rata fee will apply for fees accrued during the term. A Medical certificate is required in this case. If the incapacitation is physical in nature then the certificate needs to be issued by a physiotherapist.

4. REFUNDS

All fees (tuition or sundry) are non-refundable, non transferable nor eligible for a credit, except as specified below:

- a. WITHDRAWAL BEFORE THE TERM STARTS refund will apply, less \$50 deposit.
- b. ABSENTEEISM Where a student has been absent from scheduled classes for 4 consecutive weeks or more as a result of serious illness or injury rendering them totally incapacitated, and the member's account has been paid in full, then a credit of equal value to the value of the classes not attended (as a result of incapacitation) will be issued to the person. The credit must be redeemed before the end of the year or the following term (if the student is incapacitated during term 4). Written notice of the student's intention to apply for credit must be received by MDC on or before the commencement of the following school term, and must be accompanied by an approved Medical Certificate as verification. The balance for the following term shall be based on pro-rata fees.
- c. EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES Where a member is unable to continue with classes due to extenuating circumstances (not caused by injury), an application may be made for a refund, detailing circumstances surrounding the withdrawal. Applications will be assessed case-by-case to determine whether a refund will be issued. This will be at the discretion of the directors. An application for a refund does not entitle or guarantee a refund to be issued.
- d. CANCELLED CLASSES No refunds will be issued for classes cancelled due to public holidays (including Mothers Day & Fathers Day), sick or injured teachers (where a replacement could not be found), or temperatures over 40 degrees. If more than two cancellations occur throughout the term, the student will be reimbursed for any cancelled classes beyond the first two.
- e. STUDENTS ENROLLING IN BLOCKS OF 10 PRIVATE COACHING SESSIONS: Members must commit to the full 10 private lessons. Each 10 pack of classes will be allocated a regular time each week. Payment is required in advance. Refunds or postponements or cancellations will not apply.
- f. SINGLE (ONCE OFF) PRIVATE COACHING CLASSES: Payment is required before bookings are taken. Once the class is scheduled, refunds, postponements or cancellations will not apply, unless the teacher cancels and replacement is unavailable.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read the below information carefully.

5. RULES

- a. Members are required to attend all the classes they are enrolled in, scheduled rehearsals and performances and be punctual at all times. Unfortunately, members who persistently fail to comply with these requirements may be restricted from participating in class.
- b. Members are required to adhere to the correct uniform requirements, including footwear, in each class (refer to uniform requirement list). Baggy clothing, jewellery (incl. watches) and other unauthorised accessories are not permitted in class. Members are required to neatly tie back hair and in classical ballet classes, hair must be placed in a neat bun. Unfortunately, students who persistently fail to comply with these requirements will not be allowed to participate in class.
- c. Melbourne Dance Centre reserves the right to determine, at its discretion, the competency level of each student and will decide the appropriate class/es, performances and competition in which he / she participates or engages in.
- d. Smoking is not permitted anywhere within the school grounds.
- e. Non enrolled members of the public (including but not limited to parents, guardians or friends) are not permitted in the classroom, unless prior arrangement has been made with Administration or by request of the private lesson instructor.
- f. All patrons are required to keep the Melbourne Dance Centre premises, neat and orderly.
- g. All patrons will be responsible for their own goods & property. Melbourne Dance Centre will not be liable for any loss or damage to any person's property. Uniform or any belongings left in the studio is not the responsibility of Melbourne Dance Centre.
- h. Members who are disruptive or disrespectful towards their teachers, other students and Melbourne Dance Centre staff, will be asked not to participate in class, if the behaviour persists then membership with Melbourne Dance Centre may be terminated.
- i. All patrons and their guests shall indemnify Melbourne Dance Centre for any loss or damage to Melbourne Dance Centre's property caused directly or indirectly by the patron and / or their guest.
- j. Melbourne Dance Centre and affiliated companies shall not be liable for any injury sustained by a member or patron whilst participating in a course and/or attending the premises of Melbourne Dance Centre. Accordingly you agree to hold Melbourne Dance Centre harmless against all actions, proceedings, damages, costs, expenses, claims and demands instituted or made as a result of you, the member and or patron, sustaining a loss or injury. Whilst participating in class, members will be supervised by a qualified instructor. In the case where the member is under 18 years of age, parents are advised to collect students immediately after the class finishes and advise their children not to leave the premises without a parent or guardian.
- k. No bikes, scooters, sports equipment including balls are allowed inside MELBOURNE DANCE CENTRE. Please make sure that prams are not obstructing walk ways.
- I. Members enrolled in classes through DanceArts United or are a member of the Melbourne Dance Centre Associate Performance Academy shall not participate or become a member of another performing arts institution. Members who are found to be doing so will have their membership revoked.

6. PHOTOGRAPHIC RELEASE

- a. Members and/or parent, legal guardian, consent to Melbourne Dance Centre broadcasting & recording (by photographs, films, tape or otherwise) the member's participation in all Melbourne Dance Centre activities for utilisation throughout the world, with no limitations on time. All rights in the broadcasting & recording materials, including copyright therein and the ownership of the physical or digital materials, shall be Melbourne Dance Centre's exclusive property. Melbourne Dance Centre shall have the right to make & publish copies of the said broadcasting & recording including the right to use the student's name in relation to Melbourne Dance Centre related activities only.
- b. Members and/or parents/legal guardians, are not allowed to film or photograph during classes, rehearsals or performances, except where express authority is given by Melbourne Dance Centre or the instructor.

7. SOLO COMPETITIONS

- c. Melbourne Dance Centre affiliated companies own & control all copyright to routines and choreography and performances produced by the MDC affiliated companies ('works'). These works may not be reproduced or performed outside of each individual company's activities without the prior written consent of said company.
- d. Melbourne Dance Centre does not process solo competition entries. Accordingly Students / Parents are responsible for making their own submissions to relevant competition bodies.

8. PRIVATE COACHING CLASSES

- a. MEMBERS ENROLLING IN BLOCKS OF 10 CLASSES: Members must commit to 10 x 30 minute private lessons per term and will be allocated a regular time each week. Payment is required in advance. Refunds or postponements or cancellations will not apply.
- b. CASUAL CLASSES: Payment is required before bookings are taken. Once the class is scheduled, refunds, postponements or cancellations will not apply, unless the teacher cancels and replacement is unavailable.

9. COPYRIGHT

a. Melbourne Dance Centre and its affiliated companies own & control all copyright to routines and choreography and performances produced by the MDC affiliated companies ('works'). These works may not be reproduced or performed outside of each individual company's activities without the prior written consent of said company.

10. TEACHERS

a. Melbourne Dance Centre will attempt to maintain consistency of teaching staff for each class, particularly for students under the age of 7. As most teachers are actively working within the entertainment industry, a substitute teacher may conduct the class without prior notice.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

11. FUNDRAISING

- a. All part time students and members of the MDC Associate Performance Academy (excluding Members of the Advanced Professional Training Classes) will be required to participate in the Open Day fundraising performances.
- b. Funds raised are used to subsidise end of year costs for all students. Members who do not participate will not be entitled to discounted rate.

12. PERFORMANCES

- a. ALL MEMBERS must participate in Open Day and End Of Year Concert performances for their enrolled academies (excluding members of the Advanced Professional Training Classes). Enrolments will not be accepted without agreement of participation. Exceptions may be made for extenuating circumstances communicated to staff in writing prior to the performance term commencing.
- b. Members opting to partake is group competitions, must be enrolled in the relevant Competition class level plus an accompanying dance class in the same style. Competition involvement is compulsory for MDC Associate Performance Academy members.
- c. Miscellaneous fees for performances may include costume levies, theatre rehearsal fees, footage distribution fees and other additional rehearsal fees (if ongoing rehearsals are to take place outside of regular class times).
- d. Performances require full commitment from all members involved. Please consider rehearsal times and miscellaneous fees before signing up for non compulsory performances.

13. EXAMINATIONS

- a. Melbourne Ballet Academy members and Advanced Professional members partaking in RAD have the opportunity to participate in external examinations through the Royal Academy of Dance. Participation is by selection, and at the discretion of Melbourne Ballet Academy directors.
- b. Members participating in examinations, along with all Associate students, must undergo a mock examination through Melbourne Ballet Academy in the weeks leading up to examinations to ensure preparedness.
- c. Members are required to obtain the correct RAD specified uniform requirements for their given examination level.
- d. Miscellaneous fees for examinations include a RAD registration fee, a mock examination fee and an additional rehearsal fee (if ongoing rehearsals are to take place outside of regular class times).

14. VACCINATIONS

- a. All members partaking in classes and/or programs at Melbourne Dance Centre must have up to date vaccinations as per Australian standards. Members without up to date vaccinations will be unable to continue classes at Melbourne Dance Centre and will have their membership revoked.
- b. Whereby a member has an allergy or other medical issue with receiving vaccinations, a detailed doctor's certificate must be supplied and given to the MDC directors to review on a case per case basis.



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
